November is already here! Thank you for supporting your child to ensure they practice their spelling and Bible memory and are reading at home each week. Seeing so many Club 25 reading sheets come in has been great!

Language Arts

We are in full swing in our Reader's Workshop and guided reading groups. A favourite student activity is our *Book Buzz*, where students write down book recommendations and showcase their choice to the class. We are learning how to write descriptive paragraphs, and will soon be writing and describing creatures from their imagination. We have also started our Weekend News booklets. Watching each students' creativity shine in their writing has been a real joy these last few months.

Math

In Math, we are exploring numbers to 100,000 with a focus on place value, comparing and ordering, and skip counting. Students enjoyed our Money unit and the many ways they can represent a value with a collection of coins and bills. At the end of the term, students can continue to practice some of these math concepts in a review booklet that will be sent home during the week of Parent/Teacher Interviews.

We have also started to practice our basic subtraction facts to help build accuracy and instant recall.

Science & Social

Students are finishing their Matter unit this month. They have enjoyed our science experiments, especially the jello experiment! In Social Studies, students will learn about traditions and celebrations of Peru, Tunisia, Ukraine, and India. This is a great unit to tie in with our own celebrations and traditions during the Christmas season.
