There are new things on the horizon for 3B this month.

Language Arts

Starting this week, we will be working on handwriting! This is a very exciting time for students. Each week there will be approximately 2 pages of handwriting. Most of it will be done in class, but if a page needs to be finished it will be sent home. We will introduce all the lower and upper case cursive letters by the end of the school year. This month, we will be focusing on sequence writing and short stories. We will begin our character study unit this month as well.

Math

In Math, we will review and complete our unit on 2 and 3-digit addition and subtraction. We will continue to work on quick recall of subtraction facts to 18. Later in the month, we will be learning about multiplication to 100. Students can continue to work on a page a week in their Math Review Booklet.

We will finish our Computer Science unit this month and begin our Energy unit on forces. In Social, we will continue to learn about how communities work, focusing on goods and services, as well as how communities can work together.
